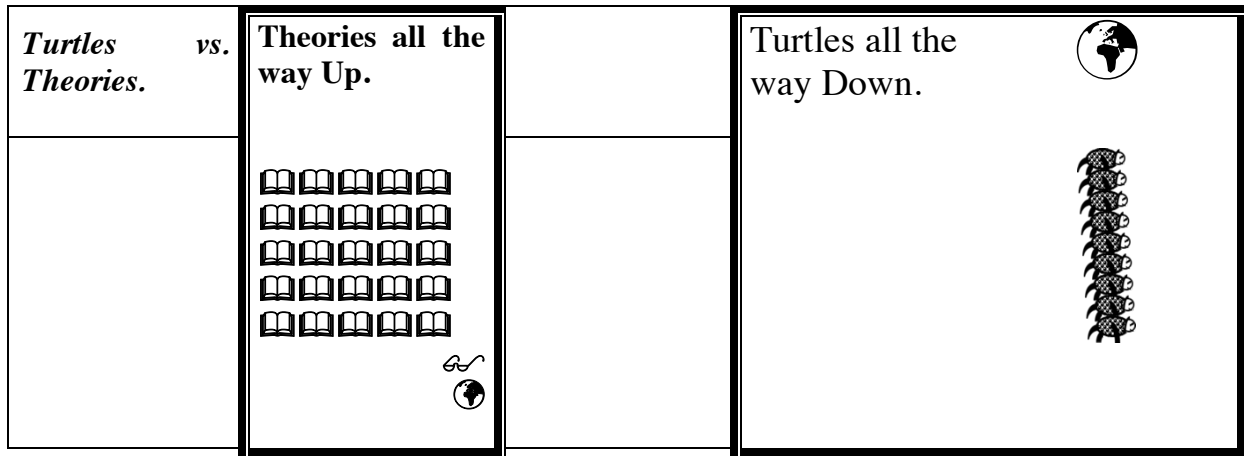


Turtles All the Way Down?
